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
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PRONE TO ABDUCTION

- New Born
- Paediatric Patients Below 14 Years

PREVENTION

- Patient Identification Bands For Mother, Child
- Restricted Entry In NICU, Wards, etc
- Adequate Security Personnel Round The Clock
- Strengthened Visitors Policy
- Pt And Family Education About Child Abuse "Never Leave Child Alone"
- Child Attenders are restricted

PREVENTION

- Defined Role and Responsibilities of Abduction Management Team (Code Pink Team) and Their Rapid Response In Time Of Abduction
- Surveillance Cameras At Key Areas Entry & Exit Of Hospitals, PICU, NICU
- For Staffs Continuous Education Of Code Pink
 - Training record to be documented
- Mock Drill At least Once in 6 Months
 - Response Time Monitoring
